

AGRICULTURAL AND TRADE DEVELOPMENT (UNITED KINGDOM, GERMANY AND UNITED STATES).

RETURN to an Order of the Honourable The House of Commons,  
dated 9 March 1914 ;—for,

RETURN “showing for the Year 1913, or latest year available, and a year 20 years earlier, for the UNITED KINGDOM, GERMANY and the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, the following information, viz. :—

- (1) Cultivated area under principal and other crops ;
- (2) Quantity of wheat, barley, oats, rye and potatoes produced ;
- (3) Quantity of pig-iron, crude steel and coal produced, and of pig-iron and coal consumed ;
- (4) Value of imports and exports (special trade), distinguishing separately “raw materials” and “manufactures” ;
- (5) Receipts from railway goods traffic, total, and per mile of line ;
- (6) Total estimated population at the middle of the year ;

showing also the percentage increase under each head between the two years specified.”
