- 3. The application of the word "dole" to "standard" benefit is wholly misleading, and even "extended" benefit is very different from Poor Law Relief.
- 4. The success of the safeguards against abuse which the scheme provides depends largely on the extent to which employers are willing to co-operate.
- 5. It is often peculiarly difficult in the case of married women to ascertain whether they are genuine seekers after work.
- 6. That the benefit paid to youths between 18 and 21 should be revised.

(If that course were adopted it would be necessary to safeguard cases in which youths were practically the breadwinners of the household.)

7. That the respective functions of the Unemployment Insurance Scheme and the Poor Law, which at present are apt to be confused, should be more clearly distinguished and more wisely co-ordinated.
