

It may be of interest to note that there was not a large difference between the income of families living in the different towns, the average being:

in Haifa	L.E. 8.50
in Tel Aviv	" 7.80
Jerusalem	" 7.70

VII. ANALYSIS OF BUDGETS.

It was necessary to find out the quantity and value of each article purchased. For this purpose the numerous items of expenditure incurred by each family were classified under 7 main categories, which were subdivided among 12 groups containing 75 articles. As food was the chief object of interest it was divided among 6 groups containing 41 articles. The details are given below:
