EXPENSES OF LOANS AND EXPENDITURES FROM REPAYMENTS

There were also received during the year obligations of the United States in the par amount of \$165,260,000 in payment of amounts due from foreign governments under funded debt agreements, of which \$29,000,000 was on account of principal and \$136,260,000 was on account of interest. These obligations have been canceled and retired and the public debt reduced accordingly.

An identical report is being submitted to the President of the Senate.
