

MEMORANDUM FOR THE PRESIDENT AND MEMBERS OF THE CABINET

There were also received during the year obligations of the United States in the amount of \$185,360,000 in payment of amounts due from foreign governments under United States agreements, of which \$29,000,000 was on account of principal and \$156,360,000 was on account of interest. These obligations have been canceled and retired and the public debt reduced accordingly.

An identical report is being submitted to the President of the Senate.
