There were also received during the year obligations of the United ates in the par amount of $\$ 165,260,000$ in payment of amounts due m foreign governments under funded debt agreements, of which $9,000,000$ was on account of principal and $\$ 136,260,000$ was on zount of interest. These obligations have been canceled and ired and the public debt reduced accordingly.
An identical report is being submitted to the President of the nate.
