## Earners in Joint Families

26. In presenting the results of the tabulation of earners in joint families according to income classes, certain headings under the first column in which the number of cases was small have been grouped under others in order to avoid too many details in the table, and the important groups only have therefore been presented. It will be seen that in nearly 71 per cent. of the cases there is more than one earner as compared with 42 per cent. in the case of natural families. In nearly 28 per cent. of the joint households the head is the only earner.
