## ACTIVITIES OF COMPENSATION BUREAU

An important function of the Bureau of Workmen's Compensation is the enforcement of the compulsory insurance provision of the Compensation Law covered under Section 305 of the Act as amended by the General Assembly in 1929.

The law now provides that any employer who fails to comply with the provisions of this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and
