## **GROWTH OF METROPOLITAN AREA**

Particular attention is drawn to the above per cent of growth of the Metropolitan Area. The tremendous growth of this territory is in that section surrounding the City of Philadelphia. The table above indicates that the Metropolitan Area's growth since 1920 was 1.41 times as rapid as the entire state of Pennsylvania, and 1.37 times as fast as the entire United States, (Continental).
