<sup>2</sup> Changes in phraseology reduces the weight limitations from 4½ to 4 ounces per square yard and increases the width limitation from 24 to 36 inches, transfers fabrics, estimated value \$2,000,000, from paragraph 1011 to paragraph 1010. Duties calculated on changed value.

<sup>3</sup> Provided that any of the handkerchiefs made with hand-rolled or handmade hems shall be subject to an additional duty of 1 cent each; estimated that 25 per cent (848,515 dozen) would be subject to the additional duty.

<sup>4</sup> Changes in phraseology reducing the weight limitations from 4½ to 4 ounces per square yard and increasing the width limitation from 24 to 36 inches, transfers fabric value estimated at \$2,000,000. Duties calculated on changed values.
