Lists of His Majesty's Consular Officers, both "salaried" and "permitted to trade," are published every quarter by the Foreign Office, and copies may be obtained on application to the Commercial Intelligence Branch.

It should be added that letters and documents addressed to Consular Officers abroad may be seriously delayed, or even in some countries fail to reach their destination, if the sender writes to the Consul personally by name and the Consul happens to be absent. All letters should be addressed to "H.B.M. Consul-General," or "H.B.M. Consul," or "H.B.M. Vice-Consul," as the case may be, "British Consulate-General," or "British Consulate," or "British Vice-Consulate," —
